
To Whom This May Concern,


When I think of someone I can turn to during anytime of need or when I just need someone to talk to, I only of one person, which is my mom Patricia Bumpers. I can't say there are too many people in the world nowadays with as big of a heart of her. My mom's heart is so big, and her love comes so genuinely. She is extremely loyal and gentle to her friends, family, and pets. Her love goes beyond what can be explained in something as simple as words. Since I can remember, my mom has always been an unconditional lover, and very high spirited. I know for a fact she has never made any attempt, to harm or hurt anything, or anybody. I was always taught to love with compassion, and the same will be given.

When our family dog Maxi, which we have had for over eight years started showing signs being unhealthy, my mom started doing everything in her power to get Maxi back in a healthy condition. My mom did everything including, feeding Maxi in bigger portions, giving her canned food in addition to her dog food, and ensuring her water was full, and clean. Unfortunately, over a short period of time, these methods did not fix the problem, and Maxi was not showing signs of improvement.

At this time, my mom reached out for a tremendous amount of help, with the hope of not only curing our dog, but also someone who would accommodate my mom's financial situation. So many times I witnessed my mom making numerous calls to different animal hospitals and visiting the Long Beach Humane Society for any kind of help. But, to our disadvantage, nobody would assist us in getting our dog well. At one point, the only thing my mom wanted to know was, what was wrong with Maxi, and from that point she could get help with treatment. After exhausting all of her options, she was left with no choice but to request Maxi be picked up in hopes Animal Control would relieve Maxi of any pain.

On the terrible day of August 20, 2009, I had to say goodbye to Maxi, but I knew she would be well taken care of. The last time I seen Maxi, she was very alert. Our entire family has loved Maxi, and we really hated to see her go. At this point, it is important for everyone necessary to know, that Maxi's health was not inflicted my mom (or anybody our family), neither was she aware what her condition was in order to treat it properly. For any families going through this same scenario, it is important they have options (free of charge) available to them to prevent another case such as this one.

To Whom It May Concern,


I have known Patricia A. Bumpers for about 2 years. We both work for the same company, CCI. Working alongside Patricia I can honestly say that she is a responsible person and is always willing to help. I have become friends with Patricia over the time that we have worked together. She is a very caring & loving person. She is a family oriented person, loves her daughters and grandchildren. I also know she cared a lot about Maxi.

Patricia is a single parent and works very hard to provide for her family. Maxi was part of her family for 8 years. When she found out that something could be wrong with Maxi, she tried very hard to look for help. The Vets she called did not want to see Maxi without a payment upfront, even though she would let them know something could be seriously wrong with Maxi and needed to be seen. Sadly the only option Patricia was left with to try and save Maxi was to give her up to Animal Control.

A few years ago my sister puppies were infected with Parvo. The puppies were really sick and we did not know what to do. Unfortunately my sister could not afford to pay for the care of the puppies and did not have credit to apply for a CARE credit card. They did not want to provide care for the puppies at the Pet Hospital unless someone would pay upfront or get approved for the CARE credit card. I then had to offer to help and put myself in debt or the puppies would not get treated. After all that we still lost one of the puppies, even though we paid upfront.

It is truly disappointing to find out what Patricia is now going thru, because she made the best decision she could for Maxi and her family. She thought Animal Control would be able to take better care of Maxi since Patricia was not getting any help from the Vets she had contacted. It's hard to understand what Patricia was expected to do when unfortunately Maxi passed away in the hands of people that are trained to care for animals. If anything good can come out of this bad situation is that I hope Veterinarian's can be a bit more considerate of the financial situation of some Pet owners and not make it a point to collect their money before caring for a patient.





Owner who dropped off emaciated dog at Carson shelter faces cruelty charge

Angel was a walking skeleton when an animal welfare group rescued the brown-and-white dog from the Carson Animal Shelter.

Suffering from diabetes and its side effects, the

dog was so skinny that even the veterinarian who oversaw the last 12 days of her life couldn't determine how old she was or her breed.

Volunteers from Santa Monica-based Take Me Home Rescue were first alerted to the dog's arrival at the shelter in late August after a desperate plea for help was posted on Facebook.

Leegie Parker quickly contacted a fellow volunteer in Torrance, who rushed over, picked up the emaciated animal and brought her to a veterinarian.

If the rescuers were horrified at the dog's condition, they were downright sickened to learn about the alleged neglect that led to it.

"This is a dog that could have easily been spared all of her suffering, had the family simply taken Angel to the doctor and had a simple blood panel run," Parker said in an e-mail. "Instead, they waited until she was almost dead and abandoned her at the shelter to suffer and die alone, scared, in a concrete cell."

His former owner, Patricia Bumpers, 48, of Carson, is now facing one count of felony animal cruelty and could be sent to prison for up to three years, according to the complaint.

Bumpers pleaded not guilty to the count at an arraignment last Friday and returns to court March 22.

Messages left for the prosecutor were not



returned.

The name of her public defender is not known, and there was no telephone listing for Bumpers.

However, Parker, who attended Bumpers' preliminary hearing last month in Compton Superior Court, said an animal control officer testified he was called to pick up the dog because Bumpers did not want her 9-year-old daughter to "come home and find her dead in the backyard."

Apparently, an animal control officer had visited the home in July and gave Bumpers a citation for not feeding the dog, Parker said.

He returned a week later, and told her to take the dog to a veterinarian, according to Parker. However, no follow-up was conducted, Parker added.

Parker said she will always be "haunted" by the words of the veterinarian who treated Angel. The veterinarian said she had never seen a dog so thin live that long.

The veterinarian estimated that Angel was about 30 pounds underweight, Parker said.

Angel received medical attention for diabetes for nearly a dozen days before dying in her sleep on Sept. 11, Parker said.

Parker takes comfort in the fact that, in Angel's last days, the friendly dog was surrounded by

people she could trust and who provided her with comfort.

Parker and others from her organization plan to continue attending Bumpers' court hearings.

"For us, it's seeking justice for Angel," she said. "But we're also seeking justice for all the others who never get their day."


